### Today's Scripture: Judges 5:6-9; 24-30

<sup>6</sup> "In the days of Shamgar son of Anath, in the days of Jael, the roads were abandoned; travelers took to winding paths. <sup>7</sup> Village life in Israel ceased, ceased until I, Deborah, arose, arose a mother in Israel. <sup>8</sup> When they chose new gods, war came to the city gates, and not a shield or spear was seen among forty thousand in Israel. <sup>9</sup> My heart is with Israel's princes, with the willing volunteers among the people. Praise the LORD!

<sup>24</sup> "Most blessed of women be Jael, the wife of Heber the Kenite, most blessed of tent-dwelling women. <sup>25</sup> He asked for water, and she gave him milk; in a bowl fit for nobles she brought him curdled milk. <sup>26</sup> Her hand reached for the tent peg, her right hand for the workman's hammer. She struck Sisera, she crushed his head, she shattered and pierced his temple. <sup>27</sup> At her feet he sank, he fell; there he lay. <sup>28</sup> "Through the window peered Sisera's mother; behind the lattice she cried out, 'Why is his chariot so long in coming? Why is the clatter of his chariots delayed?' <sup>29</sup> The wisest of her ladies answer her; indeed, she keeps saying to herself, <sup>30</sup> 'Are they not finding and dividing the spoils: a girl or two for each man, colorful garments as plunder for Sisera, colorful garments embroidered, highly embroidered garments for my neck— all this as plunder?'
